Position Summary

One World Surgery is looking for a creative, communicative, and motivated Events Manager to help plan inspirational events to grow fundraising and visibility efforts nationwide.

A critical role on the Development team, the Events Manager will organize and oversee an annual portfolio of fundraising events including the annual gala, golf tournament and national fundraising events with multiple revenue streams. It is essential for the Events Manager to have the ability to handle high volume and travel throughout the year to support each event.

The ideal candidate will have a strong background in nonprofit fundraising events and enjoy working in a fast-paced environment.

Key Responsibilities

- Manage a portfolio of events from conception through implementation and evaluation.
 Portfolio to include a gala, golf outing and 5+ national donor cultivation, stewardship and fundraising events.
- Lead event committees for each event comprised of volunteer leaders and corporate partners. Committees meet weekly in the months leading up to event and assist in soliciting sponsorships, guests and auction items. The committees also contribute to marketing materials, overall messaging and décor.
- Create and implement marketing strategies to generate interest in and increase attendance of the events.
- Manage third-party vendor relationships including venues, caterers, and AV suppliers.

- Regularly review and revise event strategies, suggest and implement areas for improvement.
- Manage all event data to ensure names of attendees, volunteers, etc. become part of the One World Surgery database; and ensure that volunteers and contributors to events are acknowledged in an appropriate and timely manner.
- Track event expenses against budget and make adjustments to ensure high level ROI.

Required Qualifications

- 5+ years successful experience in nonprofit event management with proven success in securing event sponsorship. Experience with indoor and outdoor event production is preferred.
- Knowledge and experience of marketing and communications, including production of printed materials and digital communications.
- Excellent event planning skills and attention to detail. Must be comfortable coordinating logistics, schedules and managing teams of volunteers.
- Strong financial acumen. Ability to manage, monitor and maximize a budget. Comfortable securing in-kind support.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills. Experience communicating with C-suite and other high-level donors and volunteers.
- Demonstrated experience working with third party vendors.
- An innovative thinker, who can bring fresh ideas and perspectives.
- On average 2-3 days of travel per month nationally.
- Passion for the mission of One World Surgery.

Location: Fully-remote. Travel nationally for events.

Status: Full time. Exempt from the provisions of wage and salary regulations. Salary range: \$65,000-\$75,000.
