SURGERY

Our vision is a world with safe, timely, and affordable surgical care. We are making that vision a reality in Honduras and soon in the Dominican Republic. The Holy Family Surgery Center in Honduras offers free surgical care in orthopedics, ophthalmology, general surgery, gynecology, urology, surgical oncology, spine, and ear, nose, and throat. More than 1,800 patients received transformative surgical care in Honduras.



PRIMARY & DENTAL CARE

Access to basic healthcare is a human right. We are proud to offer holistic care that treats the whole patient through primary care and dental services. Almost half of our consultations this year were geared towards these services – treatment of acute conditions, chronic disease management, dental care, and physical therapy. Our team of doctors and health promoters made hundreds of home visits to provide follow-up care and education to high-risk patients.



GLOBAL TEAM

Our local teammates are the unique differentiator of One World Surgery in the global health nonprofit community. Our patients receive continuous access to healthcare and the follow-up care that they deserve. We welcomed 26 new, passionate global teammates – the most in one year since our founding!



MEDICAL MISSIONS

We believe in transformative impact through the spirit of service. A record-breaking 1,034 volunteers worked alongside our team, provided an extension into specialty services, and enabled us to care for even more patients this year.



EDUCATION & TRAINING

We invest in future healthcare leaders. We provide scholarships, training, and development workshops for our local staff and the greater medical community. In Honduras, we launched the first orthopedic fellowship in the country, expanded our ophthalmology fellowship, and additional training opportunities.

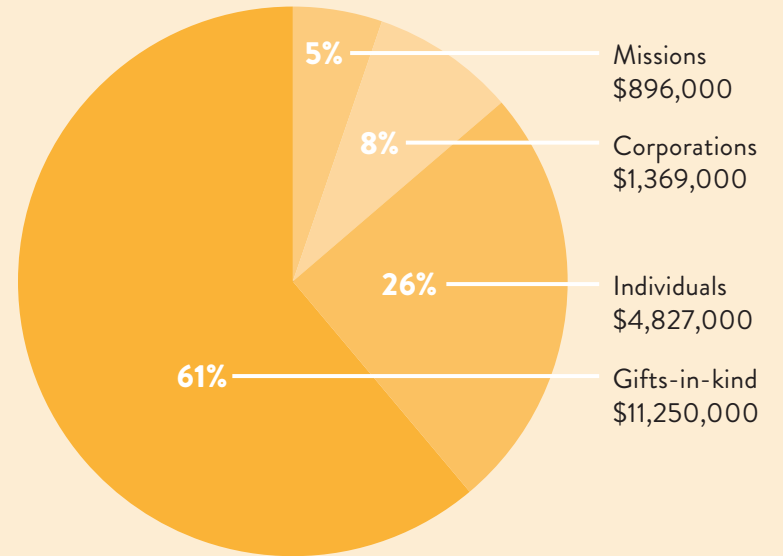


BEST-IN-CLASS FACILITIES

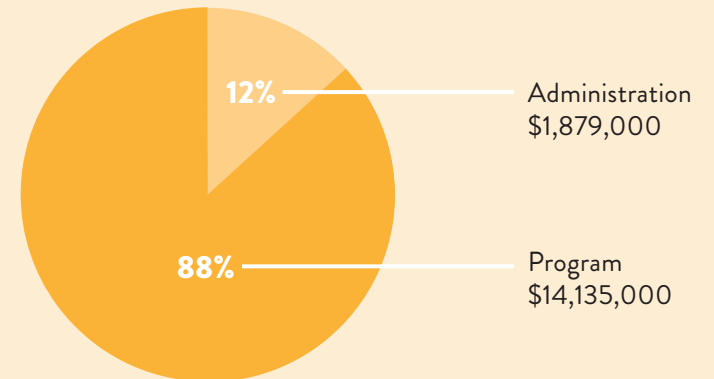
