

Our Why

- Globally, five billion people lack access to safe, timely, and affordable surgical care.
- It is estimated that **143 million additional surgical procedures** are needed annually to prevent death and disability. This indicates a significant gap between current surgical capacity and the actual need for surgical interventions globally.
- Failure to address the surgical disease burden can have severe economic consequences. Low and middle-income countries could lose up to 2% of their GDP by 2030 due to untreated surgical conditions. The global economic loss due to this is projected to be around \$12.3 trillion.
- Only 5% of the Honduran population has access to surgical care when needed.
- In the Dominican Republic, the rate of potentially avoidable premature mortality stands at 380 deaths per 100,000 population, indicating significant gaps in access to timely and effective healthcare services.
